Background: AMACR encodes a racemase. Alpha-methylacyl-CoA racemase interconverts pristanoyl-CoA and C27-bile acylCoAs between their (R)- and (S)-stereoisomers. The conversion to the (S)-stereoisomers is necessary for degradation of these substrates by peroxisomal beta-oxidation. Alpha-methylacyl-CoA racemase from this locus localize to both mitochondria and peroxisomes. Mutations in AMACR may be associated with adult-onset sensorimotor neuropathy, pigmentary retinopathy, and adrenomyeloneuropathy due to defects in bile acid synthesis. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been described. Read-through transcription also exists between AMACR and the upstream neighboring C1QTNF3 (C1q and tumor necrosis factor related protein 3) gene.

Application Notes: Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Suggested starting dilutions are as follows: WB (1:1000), IF (1:200), IHC-P (1:200).

Storage Buffer: PBS, pH 7.4, containing 0.02% Sodium Azide as preservative and 50% Glycerol.

Storage Instructions: Stable for one year at -20°C from date of shipment. For maximum recovery of product, centrifuge the original vial after thawing and prior to removing the cap. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

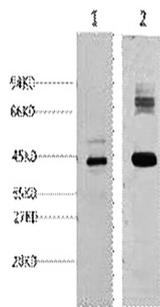


Fig.1. Western blot analysis of 1) HepG2, 2) mouse kidney, diluted at 1:1000.

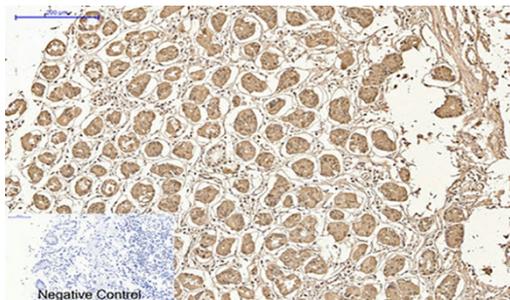


Fig.2. Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human stomach tissue. 1, AMACR Monoclonal Antibody was diluted at 1:200 (4°C, overnight). 2, Sodium citrate pH 6.0 was used for antibody retrieval (>98°C, 20min). 3, secondary antibody was diluted at 1:200 (room temperature, 30min). Negative control was used by secondary antibody only.

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
