**Background:** CD320 (CD320 Molecule) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with CD320 include Methylmalonic Aciduria, Transient, Due To Transcobalamin Receptor Defect and Methylmalonic Acidemia Due To Transcobalamin Receptor Defect. Among its related pathways are Metabolism and HIV Life Cycle. CD320 encodes the transcobalamin receptor that is expressed at the cell surface. It mediates the cellular uptake of transcobalamin bound cobalamin (vitamin B12), and is involved in B-cell proliferation and immunoglobulin secretion. Mutations in CD320 are associated with methylmalonic aciduria. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for CD320.

**Application Notes:** Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Suggested starting dilutions are as follows: WB (1:500-1:2000), ELISA (1:5000-1:20000).

**Storage Buffer:** PBS, pH 7.4, containing 0.02% Sodium Azide as preservative and 50% Glycerol.

**Storage Instructions:** Stable for one year at -20°C from date of shipment. For maximum recovery of product, centrifuge the original vial after thawing and prior to removing the cap. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
