Background: COL1A2 encodes the pro- α 2 chain of type I collagen whose triple helix comprises two α 1 chains and one α 2 chain. Type I is a fibril-forming collagen found in most connective tissues and is abundant in bone, cornea, dermis and tendon. Mutations in COL1A2 are associated with osteogenesis imperfecta types I-IV, Ehlers-Danlos syndrome type VIIB, recessive Ehlers-Danlos syndrome Classical type, idiopathic osteoporosis, and atypical Marfan syndrome. Symptoms associated with mutations in COL1A2, however, tend to be less severe than mutations in the gene for the α 1 chain of type I collagen (COL1A1) reflecting the different role of α 2 chains in matrix integrity. Three transcripts, resulting from the use of alternate polyadenylation signals, have been identified for COL1A2.

Application Notes: Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Suggested starting dilutions are as follows: WB (1:500-1:2000), ELISA (1:10000-1:20000).

Storage Buffer: PBS, pH 7.4, containing 0.02% Sodium Azide as preservative and 50% Glycerol as stabilizer.

Storage Instructions: Stable for one year at -20°C from date of shipment. For maximum recovery of product, centrifuge the original vial after thawing and prior to removing the cap. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

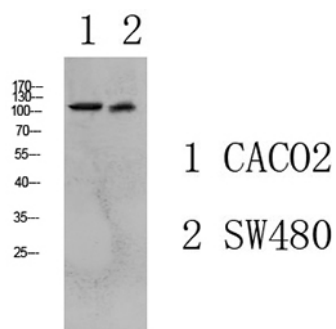


Fig.1. Western blot analysis of various lysate, antibody was diluted at 1:1000. HRP, Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG (Cat #: A21020) secondary antibody was diluted at 1:20000.

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
