**Background:** TXN (Thioredoxin) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with TXN include Breast Mucinous Carcinoma and Adult T-Cell Leukemia. Among its related pathways are Nucleotide-binding domain, leucine rich repeat containing receptor (NLR) signaling pathways and Metabolism.

**Application Notes:** Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Suggested starting dilutions are as follows: WB (1:500-1:2000), ELISA (1:10000-1:20000).

**Storage Buffer:** PBS, pH 7.4, containing 0.02% Sodium Azide as preservative and 50% Glycerol as stabilizer.

**Storage Instructions:** Stable for one year at -20°C from date of shipment. For maximum recovery of product, centrifuge the original vial after thawing and prior to removing the cap. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

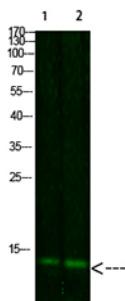


Fig.1. Western Blot analysis of 1, Mouse-liver 2, hela cells using primary antibody diluted at 1:1000 (4°C overnight). Goat Anti-rabbit IgG Dylight 800 (Cat #: A23920) secondary antibody was diluted at 1:5000 at 25°C for 1 hour.

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
