**Background:** Interleukin-6 (IL-6) is a multifunctional  $\alpha$ -helical cytokine that regulates cell growth and differentiation of various tissues, which is known particularly for its role in the immune response and acute phase reactions. IL-6 protein is secreted by a variety of cell types including T cells and macrophages as a phosphorylated and variably glycosylated molecule. It exerts actions through its heterodimeric receptor composed of IL-6R that lacks the tyrosine/kinase domain and binds IL-6 with low affinity, and ubiquitously expressed glycoprotein 130 (gp130) that binds the IL-6. IL-6R complex with high affinity and thus transduces signals. IL-6 is also involved in hematopoiesis, bone metabolism, and cancer progression, and has been defined as an essential role in directing the transition from innate to acquired immunity.

Sequence: Amino acid sequence derived from Recombinant Rat IL-6 Protein P20607 (F25-T211) was expressed.

Protein length: The Recombinant Rat IL-6 Protein consists of 187 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 21.73KDa

**Biological Activity**: Testing in progress.


**<u>Endotoxin</u>**: < 1.0 EU per  $\mu$ g of the protein as determined by the LAL method.

Formulation: Lyophilized from sterile 20 mM Tris with 150 mM NaCl, pH 7.4.

**Storage Instructions:** Lyophilized Recombinant Rat IL-6 Protein product should be stored desiccated below -20°C. Upon reconstitution, the protein should be stored at 4°C between 2-7 days and for future use below -20°C. For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA). Please prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

<u>Usage notes</u>: Always centrifuge tubes before opening. It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized Recombinant Rat IL-6 Protein using the buffer we provided not less than 100µg/ml, which can then be further diluted to other aqueous solutions.
